Richmond to restrict access to some public spaces, including James River

Richmond Mayor Levar Stoney announced the city would restrict access to certain public spaces in response to Gov. Ralph Northam's stay-at-home order.

In a release, Stoney announced playgrounds and courts at public parks, as well as on Richmond Public Schools properties, are closed beginning Monday at 5 p.m.

Access to the James River would be limited as well.

Certain activities – swimming, sunbathing or congregating in groups – are now forbidden. Residents can still exercise along the river.

Police will enforce the restrictions, the release stated.
